Viejas Casino's Celebrity Slot Tournament renders big check to the Salvation Army

The excitement of slot machines and raised voices from winners throughout Viejas Casino on Monday, November 28, was matched by a noise level of football game day when the Celebrity Slot Tournament began. At the end of the tournament a check for \$25,000 was presented to the Salvation Army.

The Viejas tournament pitted local celebrities against each other in a five-minute rally. While the Dave Patrone Quartet entertained from the stage, local celebrities including Paul Bloom (FOX 5); Isabel Cruz (chef/owner Barrio Star); Randy Jones (Padres Hall of Famer); Itica Milanes (ABC10) and Bill Walton (former NBA superstar) took their seats in front of a row of slot machines. Joining them were two mystery guests chosen through a Q&A contest of casino players and celebrity look-alikes- Frank

Sinatra (Monty Aidem) and Liza Minnelli (Gailyn Addis).

As the band played, the crowd cheered, and the celebrities pounded the buttons on the machines, Patrone prompted the players on with the excitement of a horse race calling out minute by minute who was in the lead. "Jones is slightly ahead of Itica; I can't stand it! Mystery Guest 2 is coming on strong; this is a blast!"

Once the final timer buzzed Randy Jones was declared the big winner with a total of 178,250 points. None of the players received any of the winnings. "I'm still the man," Jones said in jest. "Really, this was very fun and a great way to give back. I've done that for years and will continue to give back for thanks of all those who supported me over the years."

Walking away as she shook out her over exhausted wrist Itica Milanes beamed with

excitement. "This was the most fun I've had a charity event," she said. "Viejas did a good job, and it's great to give back. All the charities can use extra cash right now, so I was happy to be part of this."

The anticipation was palpable as everyone waited for the final tally. Showgirls filled in the atmosphere while Sinatra and Minnelli sang; and then Patrone made the announcement. The total winnings came to \$19,485.70. Then Patrone took a big gasp and said Viejas was going to round out the total winnings to \$25,000.

There to receive the check was Captain Terry Masango, director of the East County Salvation Army. "This is so appreciated," he said. "A lot of people are hurting this year and we're reaching out to 1,400 people with food and toys on December 15 and 16. We want to make sure everyone gets something, so we are very grateful to Viejas for this event."

Bill Walton said he was happy to support Viejas and the Salvation Army. "There's nothing better than putting smiles on people's faces and helping to make their lives better. And it was really fun - my hand still hurts."

Paul Bloom was so animated he couldn't contain his joy. "The Salvation Army is #1 with me," he said. "Bill Gibbs, former Padres announcer and I have enjoyed being bell ringers for the Salvation Army Red Kettle campaign for years. It was fun and for a good cause, and when Viejas does these kinds of things, I'm in."

Isabel Cruz enjoyed playing the slots and contributing her time. "It's a great cause; the Salvation Army does so much for so many people and the community at large," she said. "I enjoyed being a part of this promotion."

Dear It Doesn't Work,

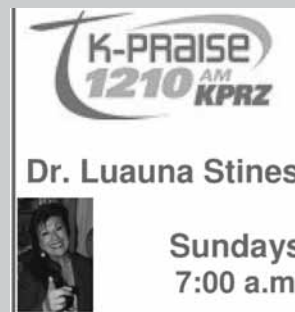

Be prepared for unexpected emergencies

On any given day, news headlines highlight disasters or other emergencies across the US, causing Americans to evaluate their own levels of

Remember the importance of critical recommendations such as texting first and talking second when cell carrier signal strength is reduced.

2. Be connected. Timely communication is key in a state of emergency. Technology allows for several channels of communication to alert people when a crisis hits. Most cities have solutions and/or services that enable residents and visitors to enroll and receive information that ranges from traffic and weather emergencies to hazardous materials situations, and everything in between.

3. Be aware. Familiarize yourself with the changes that have been made in your community to alert the public of a natural disaster, health pandemic or terrorist attack. New technologies and systems are constantly being updated and it is important to be aware how those changes affect you and those around you.

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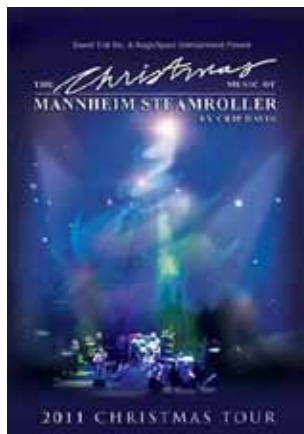

Broncos beat down the Chargers

The San Diego Chargers lost another football game Sunday, dropping their record to (4-7). This put the Chargers in a tie for last place in the AFC West with the Kansas City Chiefs. Last week the Chargers had an extremely disappointing 16-13 overtime loss to the (6-5) Denver Broncos at Qualcomm Stadium.

Losers of six consecutive losses, the Bolts are now squarely behind the eight ball, three games behind divisional leading Oakland Raiders and two games behind the Broncos.

On a day when the Chargers honored their alumni and inducted all-pro linebacker Junior Seau into the Chargers Hall of Fame, there were no big plays in any facet of game from the home town team. It was a demoralizing defeat for both the organization and the fans of San Diego.

Broncos quarterback Tim Tebow just kept his team hanging around. He ran helter-skelter and avoided a constant Bolts pass rush extending plays and making things happen. His last drive was the most meaningful, setting up Denver kicker Prater with the 37-yard game winning field goal with .29 left in overtime.

"This is the kind of game Denver plays. Run the ball and play good defense," said a dismayed Chargers head coach Norv Turner. "We had opportunities to separate from them. We weren't capable of doing it," he concluded.

The Tebow led Broncos threw the ball only 18 times and rushed for 208 yards. Willis McGahee ran rampant through the Chargers defense churning out 117 yards on 23 carries. Tebow completed just nine of 18 passes for 143 yards with no scoring passes. He did complete an 18-yard scoring pass to Decker in the second quarter. Five and one as a starter Tebow did just enough to help his team to a victory.

Chargers quarterback Philip Rivers had a mediocre day completing 50 percent of his passes 19-of-36, one touchdown to Gates on a six-yard pass in the second quarter. "He was under obvious pressure," declared Coach Turner. "I feel he managed the game as well as can be managed. When we tried to make a play we struggled to protect Rivers."

Any time your defense holds the other team to 16 points total in a game, you expect to win. The Bolts 'D' gave up over 200-yards on the ground, and could not make the big plays when needed.

On a day when he made the longest field goal of his career (53-yards) Chargers place kicker Nick Novak was asked to replicate the same feat in overtime, but to no avail missing the potential game winner wide right. This came after missing a 48-yard field goal in the fourth quarter. He did make two field goals in the game (53, 25).

Hopefully the tide will turn for Charger fans beginning next week in Florida when they tackle the Jacksonville Jaguars on Monday Night Football. Kickoff is scheduled for 5:30 p.m.

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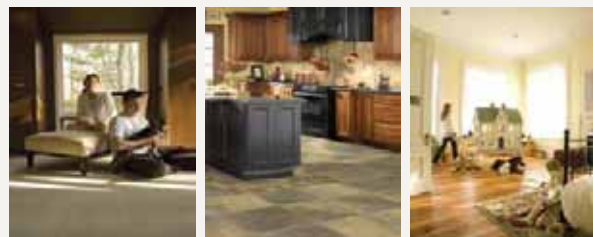

'Hugo' — an exquisite gift to moviegoers

Thank you, Martin Scorsese, for delivering a film we can finally savor this year. Adapted from Brian Selznick's novel *The Invention of Hugo Cabret*, *Hugo* had barely begun its journey before I sensed it would be very special.

Hugo, played by Asa Butterfield — who wowed audiences

with this 2008 performance in *The Boy in the Striped Pajamas* — is a tough and inventive orphan living in the clock tower of a Parisian train station in 1931. Why he wanders through a maze of floors and stairways to make sure the clocks are always on time is at first a mystery. Where's his family? And why does he have to steal food?

The answers lie with Scorsese, who delights in slowly

unfolding the mystery and magic of John Logan's beautiful screenplay. It's soon revealed that Hugo's father passed away, and his uncle (Ray Winstone), who was left to care for Hugo, eventually took off. So Hugo has made the train station his home. He scurries around through vendor carts with the speed of a mouse, and is just as quick at grabbing fruit or a bread bite before he's caught.

Although doing a great job staying yards in front of the zany — and over-the-top — station inspector (Sacha Baron Cohen), Hugo finally gets snared by an elder shop owner (Ben Kingsley) when he tries to grab a magic item. The owner plays Hugo while being watched by his goddaughter Isabelle, (Chloe Grace Moretz). She befriends Hugo, telling him to stand up to her godfather who has taken a very precious booklet from Hugo.

The two youths become fast friends, each teaching the other amazing things about their lifestyles. Isabelle feels she's on a great adventure with Hugo, and he becomes mesmerized by her love of books. Hugo also learns that Isabelle's godfather and guardian is the famous filmmaker Georges Méliès, who gave up a life behind the camera making impressive early films — and refuses to even talk about them.

Inside the meager space where Hugo has made his home sets a mechanical man known as an automaton. In a flashback scene Hugo's dad (Jude Law) lovingly explains the magic of the automaton, who could write a message

to them if only they had the heart-shaped key to wind him up.

The production design of *Hugo* by Dante Ferretti (*Sweeney Todd: The Demon Barber of Fleet Street*, *The Aviator*) looks like a brilliant glistening ornament on a bare Christmas tree. It's exquisite. Every corner Hugo turns, every person in the station — such as the flower girl (Emily Mortimer) or book shop owner (Christopher Lee) — reveals a moment of awe and pure magic. Cinematographer Robert Richardson (*Inglourious Basterds*, *The Aviator*) uses his talented eye behind the camera to catch and enlighten every aspect of the enduring story.

Scorsese went one step further with this film by making it in 3D, but not the maddening 3D that has encompassed many of the more recent 3D films. Scorsese became attracted to 3D when Alfred Hitchcock used it in *Dial M for Murder*. Describing his perspective of the effect Scorsese created in this film, Kingsley said, "I suppose it's a little bit like an artist going from fine portrait painting to landscape painting. It's a shift in the way he puts his brush, but it's the same brush and it's the same canvas."

In addition to a sensational cast, there are some real treasures here for classic movie fans, especially those aware of George Méliès' work. As a director, he made more than 500 films starting in the late 1800s. *Hugo* spotlights a few such as *A Thousand and One Nights* and *A Trip to the Moon*, a 1902 film where a rocket flew into the eye of the man in the moon.

Nominated for seven Academy Awards, but winning only one (*The Departed*), Scorsese's *Hugo* ends up as a wonderful tribute to creative storytelling, early cinema and magic. I hope the Academy recognizes the extraordinary gift he has given film lovers everywhere.

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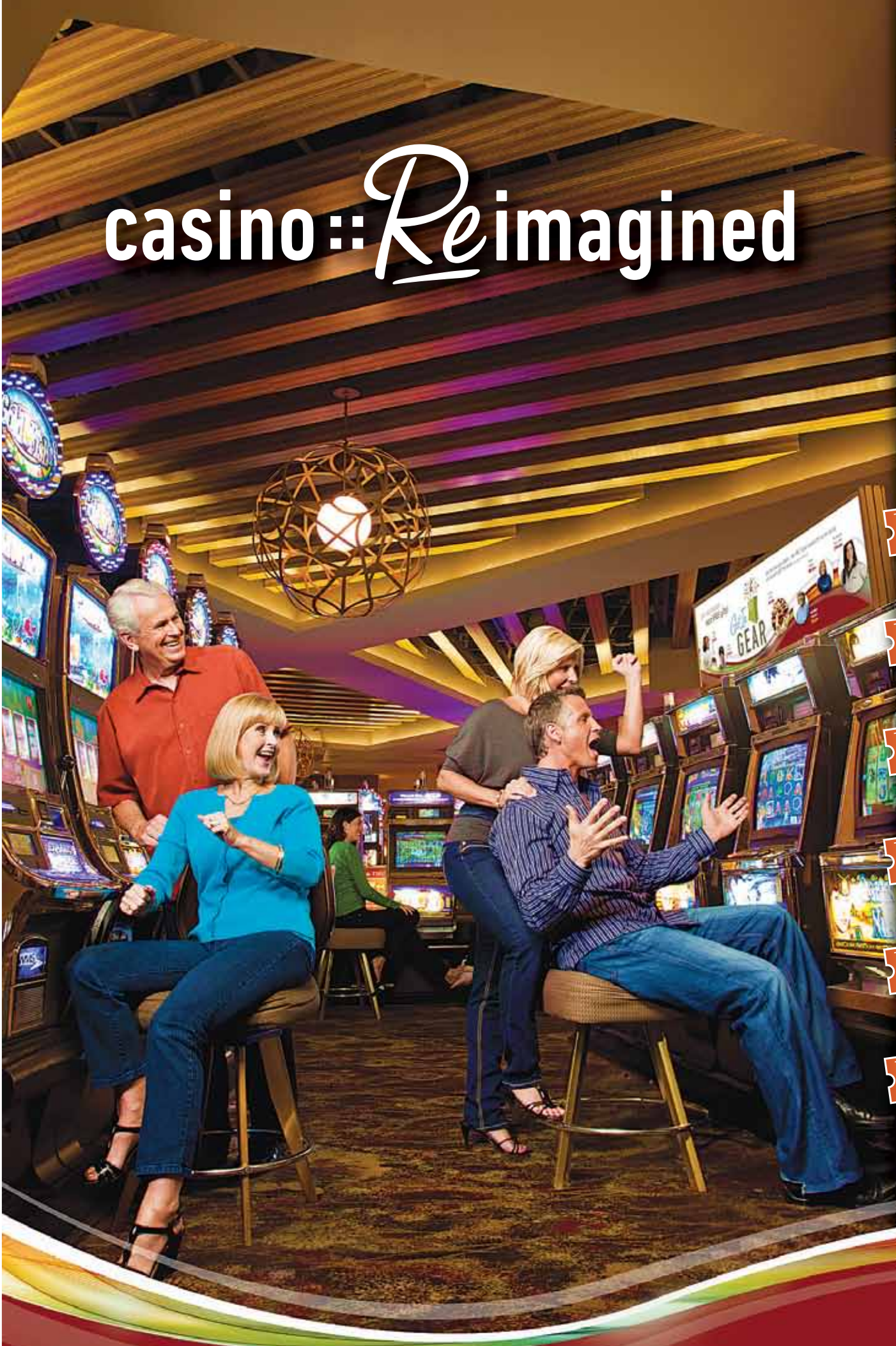

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

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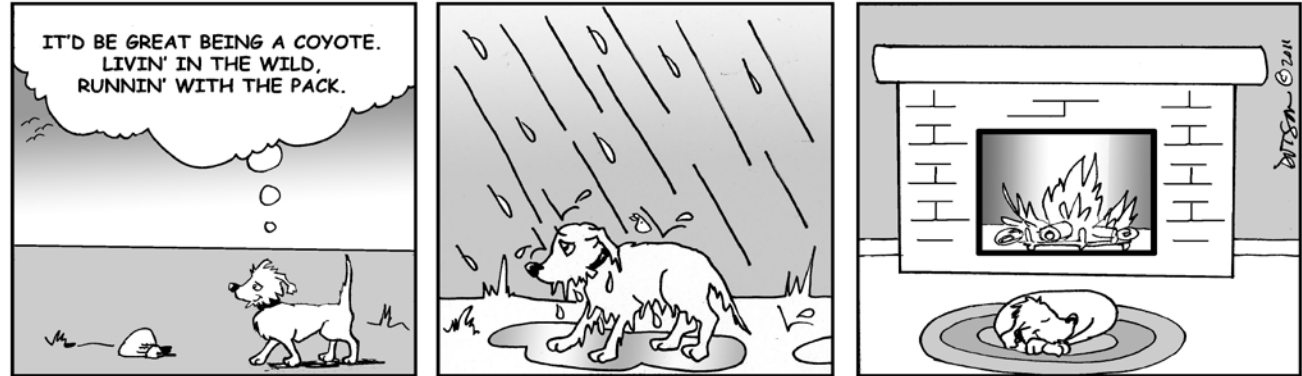
