



Alpine Veterans Wall of Honor to be featured in TV commercial

n early October Alpine's Dan Foster and his wife Kim went to Las Vegas to watch the first event of the PBR (Professional Bull Riders) competition. After getting home Kim noticed a commercial for people to enter to have a Ford Motor CO TV commercial shot in their hometown. The requirement was that the person selected own a Ford Truck, be a huge PBR fan and have done something special in their community.

Kim submitted a form explaining how Dan founded the Alpine Veterans Wall of Honor. She was asked to send in more information and then they called to speak to Dan. They later informed him they would be coming to Alpine to film a Ford Motor Truck commercial at the Wall of Honor.

On December 12, a crew from Ford Motor Company came to Alpine and began scoping out the town. They spent long hours with Dan and on Friday the 13th began interviewing those on or connected with the Veterans Wall for a separate airing in conjunction with the commercial. Supervisor Dianne Jacob, a big part of the green-light for the wall to be built, was interviewed at Foster's house.

On Saturday Morning at another Wall Ceremony where 18 new tiles were placed, the crew filmed with nearly 200 people in attendance.



So no pets are roaming around our house but I do have a variety of pet peeves. My wife graciously allows me to keep my pet peeves as long as I keep them to myself and that they do not mess up the house. For the most part, I try to do that, but occasionally one of my pets escapes from its pen.

A pet peeve that recently escaped from its cage is, people taking something out of context to prove their point. You can make anything say and mean anything you want it to say or mean. The politicians have perfected this art and I think it ought to remain within the confines of Washington DC.

It always amazes me that politicians can virtually say the



To say that the English author is a bit uptight is to say peanut butter is boring without jelly. When her agent finally gets Travers to go to Los Angles and meet with Walt, he gets more than he expected.

When Ralph (Paul Giamatti), Disney's limo driver, picks up Travers at the airport and welcomes her to the City of Angels, she replies, "It smells."

"Jasmine," he responds.

"No; chlorine and sweat," she replies in a manner that paints a vivid picture of her personality. Travers is not any more friendly when she meets Walt and insists she will call him "Mr." Disney and he call her "Mrs." Travers.

Walt tries everything to get Travers to sign over the film rights. He brings in Disney's best -- writer Don DaGradi (Bradley Whitford) and The songwriting Sherman brothers Richard (Jason Schwartzman) and Robert (B.J. Novak). She's appalled at their first draft of silly songs, "A Spoonful of Sugar" and "Chim Chim Cher-ee." And she demands "no animation." That leaves the penguins in the story up in the air.

It's not until Walt begins to

dig into Travers childhood that he learns why she's so protective of her story. Back flashes that begin when the movie stars already revealed scenes of her as a child, Helen Lyndon Goff (Annie Rose Buckley). Her family was in hard times in Australia. Her father (Colin Farrell) -- a heavy drinker -was rarely able to support the family, but loved Helen. He always rebuffed her defeated and ill-spirited mother's (Ruth Wilson) wisecracks.

It's an interesting journey to get Travers to believe she's in the, "Happiest Place on Earth," but Academy Awardnominated director John Lee Hancock (The Blindside, The Alamo. The Rookie) handles the story and the cast well.

Hanks doesn't come close to his best performance to date as in Captain Phillips, but his persona of Walt Disney is believable by his effervescent personality and unrelenting efforts to push for a vision that made incredible history as a film. (The 50th Anniversary of the DVD was recently released.)

Farrell is very heartfelt as Helen's father; and Schwartzman and Novak are terrific and funny as the Sherman Brothers. There's rarely a character

that Thompson can't portray, and she does excel here as one of the most bitter and frosty women to enter Disney halls. Luckily there's always magic to be found there.

Saving Mr. Banks, a 2013 American-British-Australian historical comedy-drama film directed by John Lee Hancock, is a wonderful family film or one for those who might not realize some of the numerous tasks it takes to get


New DVDs to fill out the holidays



'Women on Target' class has long waiting list

ecently I had the opportunity to attend a 'Women on Target' clinic sponsored by the NRA and held at the Lemon Grove Gun Club in Alpine. The purpose of this clinic is to

provide safety when handling and shooting firearms.

The clinic has continued to be held every four months and several years. The classes are so popular, there is an eight month waiting list to attend the class. Each clinic allows 42 women the opportunity to learn proper handling of firearms.

Upon arriving at the Gun Club, each woman checked in and was given a 'Women on Target' bag filled with safety goggles, ear plugs, snacks and brochures on the 'Women on Target' program.

The women were split into three groups, which are then rotated into the three segments; shotguns, rifles and handguns.

I've been around firearms most of my life, but have had very little experience in handling or shooting. The most I can remember handling a gun was when I was very young with my dad. He had me shooting his shotgun (and I can still remember how much fun that was!) But the lack of handling firearms as an adult made me uncomfortable. Having children and grandchildren living with me and the fact that I own mu own business, made me think "what if?" What if I was home alone with my children and/or grandchildren and someone or someones' came by to threaten us. What if I was working alone at my business late at night and someone tried to break in. Sure, there is always 911, which I would call immediately, but what if they didn't get to us in

time. I'm no match against one man, let alone several with or without weapons. For my safety, and the safety of others whom I'm responsible for, I needed to get comfortable with handling firearms.

The first class I attended was the shotgun portion. The class began with a 15 minute talk on proper handling of the shotgun followed by 40 minutes of shooting clay discs with one-on-one training with an instructor. I first shot a 12 gauge shotgun. My instructor explained the proper way to grip the firearm to minimize recoil into my shoulder, "So you don't go home with a black and blue momento of the class," my instructor said. Having had surgery two years back, resulting in a bar and eight screws in my neck, this was a little worrisome.

Once the instructor felt comfortable with my stance and my grip with the shotgun, "pull' was called and I shot at the clay target. After three tries, I began to hit the flying targets, and wow, was it fun! After approximately 30 minutes, the seven pound shotgun began to feel quite heavy for me. Being a computer nerd, these muscles haven't been used in years. I switched to a 20 gauge shotgun for the final 10 minutes, which had more recoil, but lighter for my weakened muscles. Proudly, I moved onto the next class with no "momento" bruises on my shoulder.

My group moved over to the next class with rifles. This class began, again, with 15 minutes

of safety instructions and how to properly handle rifles. In this class, there were 14 stations set up, one for each woman in the group to sit down at a table with an instructor by her side, paper targets in front of each of us and several miscellaneous targets at various distances to shoot once we felt comfortable handling the rifles.

My weakened arm was overjoyed to have a table to help hold and aim my rifle. Although, after 40 minutes, this motion was also felt in my arm. I've heard people calling shooting a sport, but I never realized how many muscles and skill it actually does take, it truly is a sport.

After shooting the shotgun, I figured shooting a rifle would be a piece of cake; no recoil, a table to help steady the rifle and sites to line up the target. Wrong.... the rifle took me much longer to dial in so that I could hit the targets in the places I wanted to hit them. But, with the help of my instructor, and lots of ammo later, I dialed it in and hit the spots I wanted to. Again, lots of fun!

Next we ventured over to the hand gun section. Again, 14 stations for the women in the group to shoot from. I saw an elderly gentleman at the end station who looked patient and kind, so I scattered over to him. His name was Mac, and as it turned out, he has trained military and sheriffs to shoot for years. Mac is 90 years young, although I'm not sure I believe him. His wit, strength and

knowledge was unbelievable.

Mac first handed me a Colt Ace 22 caliber semi-automatic handgun. First, the firearm was beautiful, and he must have trained it well, because I began hitting the center of the target instantly. He said I was a natural.... I say I had a great instructor.

After shooting the Colt Ace for a bit, Mac switched me to a 38 Revolver. Now this handgun was a little more intimidating with much more recoil, but again, with a little practice and a lot of coaching, I was hitting the targets with ease. Much to my surprise, I also became quick on the reload. This was especially amazing to me because I have "fumble fingers" due to arthritis.

At the end of the clinic, the women all met together and received a Certificate of Achievement for the 'Women on Target' program.

One might think that this class is for young women or a certain 'type' of woman, but that couldn't be further from the truth. These 42 women, who got together for this clinic, were from ages 18 to their 80's. Each one different from the other. The one thing they all had in common was the desire to protect themselves and the big smiles they had on their face at the end of the day.



Chiefs and chips fall the Chargers way

harger fans can pack

their bags. For the first time in four years the Chargers are in the playoffs and headed to Cincinnati.

Finishing the regular season winning four in a row, San Diego was awarded the sixth and last Wild Card spot Sunday after defeating the Kansas City Chiefs 27-24, in a thrilling overtime victory seen and heard by 66,374 at Qualcomm

Needing to win their last four games, the Bolts also needed and relied on help from Baltimore and Miami to lose (which they did twice).

Credit Chargers rookie Head Coach Mike McCoy and his staff for motivating and inspiring the team to move forward especially when the chips were low. It was two short weeks ago the team was given a 3 percent chance of making the playoff according to some "experts."

In a division once mired in mediocrity, the AFC West continues to flex their muscles. This year it sent three teams of six competing for the AFC in the 2013 playoffs.

The most unlikely Wild Card contender, the San Diego Chargers hit the trifecta twice in order to advance and keep their season going.

Destiny on their side, the Chargers overcame adversity from a win-lose, roller-coaster season under the direction of a rookie Head Coach and staff. Yet they never folded their tents and got tough when the going got tough and beating the better teams on their schedule -- on the road.

The overtime win against Kansas City at home didn't come easu.

The Chargers "never give up" attitude, and the noise produced by the fans in the stands proved to be the difference in this win.

Chargers Head Coach Mike McCoy said, "I want to start by thanking the fans again. The noise, how loud it was in the fourth quarter is what it needs to be like all the time. It's great for the players, the coaching staff, and everyone there that puts out all the hard work. It was outstanding to

finish the season that way at home.

McCoy added, "About the game; it wasn't always perfect. We talked about the character of the team all year long and how our guys have worked from the very first day here. They have done an outstanding job. They have bought in. They believe in one another.'

With the score tied at 24 apiece Chiefs kicker Ryan Succop missed a 41-yard field goal that would have ended the Bolts season; instead it sent the game into overtime.

The key play that swung momentum the Bolts way happened next. Facing fourth down and two, on their 27yard line, Chargers free safety/ special teams up-man Eric Weddle calling his own number took the direct snap from a punt formation and drove into the pile keeping his legs churning while getting pushed from behind by fullback Le Ron McClain. On second and third efforts Weddle got the first down by inches. This was a gutsy call from a gutsy player, allowed by a gutsy coach.

"I saw a six man (Chiefs in the box). Coach gave me the reign to call it (fake punt). Probably wasn't the most ideal field position, but luckily I got great blocking," said Weddle.

The Chargers put together a 16-play, 62-yard drive culminating in a Nick Novack 36-yard field goal that proved to be the game winner after KC QB Chase Daniel ended the game on an incompletion he threw past the line of scrimmage.

Kansas City wasted little time getting on the scoreboard first after the Chargers deferred. Resting all of his starters except one, KC backup quarterback Chase Daniel found wide receiver A.J. Jenkins for 41-yards with Knile Davis ran it in from 17-yards out giving KC a stunning 7-0 lead just two minutes into the contest. Daniel had a good game, completing 21-of-30 passes for 200-yards.

Chargers quarterback Philip Rivers had a good day completing 22-of-33 passes for 229-yards, throwing three touchdowns, one interception (Keenan Allen slip).

Ryan Mathews led the way for Chargers running back churning out 144-yards on 24 attempts averaging 6.0 yards

In a rematch from an earlier loss to Cincinnati less than a month ago, there will be no surprise game plan from the Bengals. Their QB Andy Dalton coming off four interceptions last week will be looking to exploit San Diego's secondary. The Chargers will have to play better and get a decent pass rush on the opposing quarterback.


The Chargers are the only West Coast team to travel this weekend.


