In Ricki and the Flash, Streep plays Ricki Rendazzo, a mother who might have made some wrong choices in her life, but a woman determined to follow her dream as a rock star singing in a band and playing guitar.

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Demme directs the film written by Diablo Cody, Oscar Winner for Juno. Cody said she got the idea from her mother-in-law.

Demme could have gone the "overlay a previously-recorded, perfect track," route, but he wanted this to be a real band. He cast Rick Springfield as Greg, Ricki's boyfriend.

"With this kind of character-driven film, we have to make people feel like it's

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real," Demme said. "It never occurred to me to do anything other than make the band real. I wanted this great band, with Meryl at the center, to really get out there and play.

Streep knew how to sing, and took months of lessons on an acous-

The cast of the film is great, Mamie Gummer, Streep's real daughter, has become quite a good actor in her own right, and watching Springfield both in a romantic role and a rock 'n' roller is fun and enjoyable.

I liked the initial plot. However, it didn't seem to paint a solid picture of Ricki vs Linda. More of a background of the family relationship might have helped. Especially since Linda and Pete seemed to get along really well when she went to visit. I also wondered why Linda ended up going across the country without any money. Surely Greg would have made sure she had enough for her needs.

Still, it's fun watching Streep and Springfield along with the other band members — Bernie Worrell, a founding member of Parliament-Funkadelic, and member of the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame; Rick Rosas

uy Ritchie's The Man From U.N.C.L.E. is not like the creaky old 1960s TV show. - it's infinitely better! Now 50 years later and more can be done on massive movie screens to thrill audiences and suck them right into the story than could never have been shown on a tiny screen-in-a-box.

Although audiences are being inundated with action films, super-hero films, and space movies this summer, The Man from U.N.C.L.E stands out from the crowd because it is injected with some humor and teasing between the two main characters, Napoleon Solo (Henry Cavill) and Illya Kuryakin (Armie Hammer). With a script written by director Guy Ritchie and Lionel Wigram and a story by Jeff Kleeman, David Campbell with

the two previously mentioned men, lots of testosterone-fueled humor ignites the two leading men into the best "bromance" on screen to date.

Solo has always worked with the CIA, and his counterpart Kuryakin is a KBG Operative in Russia. Always hating each other, their main goal was to kill off the other and rid the world of "espionage of a scourge" — each's interpretation of one another. However, a new threat to the world has cropped up in the form of a mysterious international crime organization bent on capturing the market on nuclear weapons. It's fun to watch them be creative about how to bash the enemy in an effective way while miraculously escaping any injuries to themselves. Fantasy? For sure, but it makes for a more enjoyable thriller.

How will they find the nefarious leader of the dreaded organization? Their only lead is Gaby (Alicia Vikander), the daughter of a German scientist who is missing and nowhere to be found. The boys also find her in a race against certain destruction in a nuclear accident. Without much to do – compared to the boys — Vikander shows promise as a leading lady.

Notice must be taken of Elizabeth Dibicki as the evil Victoria Vinciguerra. A more elegant looking woman you will probably never meet, but the horrible things in her mind will make you run screaming in the opposite direction. Swathed in a fashion-killing wardrobe by costume designer Joanna Johnston, Debicki puts all Parisian runway models to shame. At the same time, she is plotting some of the worst crimes against mankind imaginable and pulls it off with panache. Dibicki
