

Pump Storage Project at San Vicente Reservoir

Water Authority and the City of San Diego have been issued preliminary permits by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission to investigate the development of a pump storage project at the San Vicente Reservoir.

During the November public meeting at the Lakeside Community Center a project overview was presented by the joint permittees. The project would involve creating a small upper reservoir above the existing San Vicente Reservoir, along with a tunnel system and an underground powerhouse to connect the two bodies of water. The powerhouse would contain four reversible pump turbines.

The audience was told the pump storage facilities are an important tool for generating clean power by harnessing the energy in the water as it flows down the hill between the reservoirs. During off peak periods when power is inexpensive and renewable supplies exceed demand turbines would pump water to the upper reservoir where it would work as a battery of stored energy.

During peak energy demand the systems would create carbon free power as the water from the upper reservoir flows downhill through the turbines. Transferring water would not consume water held in storage.

During the pump storage study it will be determined whether water supply, water quality, fisheries or recreational use of the reservoir will be effected.

Power generated at the San Vicente pump storage facility would be delivered to the regional energy grid by new transmission line for the most part running parallel to the Sunrise Power link corridor. The new line would connect at the electrical substations five miles away.

The Water Authority and the City of San Diego are inviting public comments concerning the studies to be conducted during the early decision making process.

Too much turkey and not enough gravy

This time of the year, my thoughts drift back to memories of my maternal grandmother. The Thanksgiving season brought all her special talents to the forefront. To me, my grandmother reigned as queen of the kitchen and functioned as the World's Greatest Cook.

Thanksgiving brought all my relatives to my grandmother's house. My grandfather lived there too, but with all the food on the table, nobody noticed.

To be honest, my grandmother did not do everything. My grandfather made a major contribution to the Thanksgiving preparation. In fact, he had the most important part — he stayed out of grandmother's kitchen. I have always appreciated that quality of my grandfather.

As November made its debut, everyone in my family eagerly awaited Thanksgiving Day. We talked of nothing else for weeks in advance. Someone might think all this excitement about Grandmother's Thanksgiving spread a little extreme. That is simply because they never had any of her "vittles." One bite, or even one good whiff, could convince anyone that my grandmother's cooking ranked number one. There were times when circumstances severely challenged Grandmother's patience, if not her sanity. But no matter what happened, she always came through with fried goodies. No matter what the crisis, somehow my grandmother had the perfect recipe.

One year, contrary to her usual good sense, my grandmother allowed my grandfather to watch the turkey while she went down the road for an important meeting at the church. As an active member of her church, Grandmother felt an obligation to do her part. "If everybody did their part," she explained to me once, "everything would get done."

Although not completely comfortable leaving the important turkey under Grandfather's watchful eye, Grandmother felt she had no other option.

"Jim," she said to my grandfather, "I want you to pay attention to every word I say."

My grandfather was a great old man. I always enjoyed the many romps I had with him. He seemed to know exactly what children liked to do. Despite Grandmother's warnings, he somehow managed to sneak in a little fun for his grandchildren. For example, there was the time he let all the grandchildren slide down grandmother's banister. But trusting my grandfather with something as important as the Thanksgiving turkey was just asking too much.

"Jim," grandmother instructed, "all you have to do is make sure the turkey doesn't go dry. Just baste the turkey every 15 minutes with this turkey baster and make sure it doesn't go dry." To make sure my grandfather understood the importance of her instructions, Grandmother added one last note. "If this turkey goes dry, your goose is cooked."

We all knew Grandmother was not joking. She never joked about her cooking. Martha Stewart could learn a thing or two about culinary etiquette from my grandmother.

To be brutally honest about the whole incident, it was not my grandfather's fault that the meeting at the church lasted as long as it did. Everyone knows church committee meetings sometimes have a life of their own and can go on for days.

During the first hour of his vigil, my grandfather did everything my grandmother instructed him to do. However, it was cold outside and the old-fashioned wood stove in the room off the kitchen spread a warm blanket throughout the house, creating a drowsy ambience. Turning to my grandmother, he continued. "Mary, this has to be the best gravy you've ever made." My grandmother smiled one of her maternal smiles and everyone went back to the business of the day.

Swap out sugar for better health

ou probably real-ize that eating too many sugary foods and gaining weight go hand in hand. What you may not know is that aside from loading up on calories that help pack on the pounds, consuming too much sugar can also harm your health in other ways.

Consuming more than nine teaspoons of sugar a day for men and six teaspoons for women can lead to health problems, such as tooth decay, obesity and depression. Reducing your sugar intake can help more than your waistline; it can improve your overall health.

First, it's important to recognize that there are two types of sugar - natural sugar and added sugar. Natural sugar is found in fruits, milk and some whole grains. Added sugar is sugar that is added to processed foods and drinks, such as cookies, cereals and soda.

Added sugar affects your body in many ways. It can be as addictive as drugs, tobacco or alcohol because it affects the same regions of the brain, triggering the pleasure sensors to release dopamine. Dopamine

When you consume too much added sugar, your liver has to work extra hard to process it. Excess sugar in the liver often turns into fat, which can lead to liver damage or other health concerns, such as high cholesterol, diabetes or heart disease

It can also overload and damage your pancreas, which controls the blood sugar called insulin that powers your muscles and organs. Lack of insulin can cause muscle and nerve damage.

Limit added sugars in your diet with these healthy alternatives:

Skip sugary cereals at breakfast. Instead, opt for a protein-rich meal. Options, such as eggs, turkey sausage and whole-wheat toast with peanut butter are healthier ways to fuel your day.

Bring healthy snacks to work to ward off the temptation of sugary treats. Some smart choices include: frozen grapes, trail mix, yogurt, almonds, apple slices and peanut butter with celery sticks.

Instead of pie, donuts or cake, curb your sweet tooth craving by reaching for fresh fruit, low-fat frozen yogurt or a fruit and yogurt parfait.

If you can't substitute a fruit, make your treats small, such as a single fun-size piece of candy.

Sodas, energy drinks and sports drinks sneak in a lot of sugar calories. In fact, a single can of soda has nine teaspoons of sugar – the maximum an adult male should consume in an entire day. Skip the sugary beverages and try hot or iced tea, fizzy water or lemon water instead.

'Trumbo' a courageous and funny take on dark history

screenwriter Dalton Trumbo sacrificed his lucrative Hollywood career during the dark days of the infamous Hollywood witch-hunt during the 1940s and 1950s. He stuck to his principles and wouldn't "name names. "He insisted he was entitled to his own thoughts and ideas without the danger of censorship looming over him.

During World War II when Russia was a U.S. ally, it was not illegal to join the Communist Party. Many liberalleaning artists in Hollywood and New York took advantage of that and innocently joined the Communist Party, thinking that it embodied all their righteous ideals. Wrong! There were many in Washington who thought that being a Communist was against all American ideals and therefore traitorous to the country.

In 1947 the House Un-American Activities Committee convened in Washington to question 10 Hollywood screenwriters about the influence Communism had on Hollywood films and whether there were Communist agents infiltrating the movie industry. Trumbo was one of the men called. All the men refused to give information and were held

in contempt of Congress. They were blacklisted in Hollywood, and Trumbo served almost a year in prison in 1950. Moguls such as Louis B. Mayer of MGM (Richard Portnow) led the parade of not employing any of the screenwriters from that point.

Bryan Cranston (*Breaking Bad*) takes on the monumental task of playing Dalton Trumbo, and dominates the screen in almost every scene. It's a marvel-

ous film and Cranston is even more spectacular in capturing Trumbo's natural humor, intelligence, and determination to stick to his principles. Whether you agree with Trumbo's politics or not, he has to be admired for upholding what he thought were free speech rights given all Americans.

Cranston portrays Trumbo as a hysterically funny, thoughtful, smart and courageous man who had a lot to lose in his career. He wrote some of the most significant films during the Golden Age including A Bill of Divorcement, Kitty Foyle (Oscar for Ginger Rogers), Thirty Seconds Over Tokyo and Roman Holiday which won Trumbo Oscar in 1953 for the screenplay).

Michael Stuhlbarg as Edward G. Robinson, gets caught up in the hysteria and even hosted some meetings of the writers at his home. But he was never a Communist and ultimately distanced himself from Trumbo to save his own career.

Austrian-American film director Otto Preminger worked with Trumbo in defeating the infamous Black List. Preminger, known for his films Laura and Anatomy of a Murder, was somewhat of a rebel. He was the first director to hire Trumbo and give him his first screen credit in 10 years for writing Exodus (1960), thus breaking the Black List. Actor/producer Kirk Douglas, portrayed by Dean O'Gorman, followed and hired Trumbo to write the smash gladiator picture Spartacus, also in 1960.

Audiences will be fascinated with the inner workings of Washington in the 1950s, but also enjoy the acting prowess of the cast. Helen Mirren is tops as the vicious, commie-hater and Hollywood columnist Hedda Hopper who wants to destroy Trumbo. John Goodman gives a comical performance of schlock movie producer Frank King of the infamous King Brothers Productions. Christian Berkel plays the subdued but stylish director Otto Preminger. David James Elliot captures John "Duke" Wayne perfectly as an extreme right wing advocate. Elle Fanning shows she has great potential as an actress, and stand-up comic Louis C.K. steals the picture as a supporting actor plaving blacklisted writer Arlen Hird.

The premise of the picture might be a very serious one, but it is relieved with many comical moments by Cranston and Goodman. It's well-worth seeing and is a topic for interested American citizens.

'The 33,' true life story riveting and inspiring

Review by Diana Saenger here's nothing new about real disasters becoming movies. The Perfect Storm, The World Trade Center, and The Impossible (about the 2004 Tsunami) are but a few we've seen. Now there's The 33, retelling the 100-year-old gold and copper mine catastrophic disaster in Chile that had 33 miners trapped underground.

We saw a lot about the 2010 incident on the news about trying to get the miners out, distraught and angry families, and how those in charge had to up their game

No one can imagine the personal trauma and despair of someone being buried 2300 feet below ground and superiors who have no idea how to get them out. And that's what the story is about; how these 33 miners spent 69 days wondering if they will starve to death, die of dehydration, injuries sustained in the crash, or their mental stress thinking about the families that they might never see again and how they would survive without their relatives' income.

Antonio Banderas leads this cast as de facto leader of the miners, Mario Sepúlveda. It's his job to ration a few candy bars with tiny bits to each of the miners and share one small carton of milk. At first the miners are fine and go along with what he says. However, there's usually one or two in the bunch that thinks they are entitled and who try to confiscate some of the rations.

At that point Mario steps in to give them the lowdown of how things will be whether they like it or not. Banderas is so real throughout the film but particularly in this scene as if he had experienced this ordeal himself. He both chastises and exudes his concern for the men who seem to agree with him. He's the one that must be the bold savior in this regard and with his own fear.

Mario tells them, "They'll dig us out. If they don't our families will, with their bare hands if it's necessary. I believe we'll make it out of here because I choose to believe it. All 33 of us!"

Lou Diamond Phillips doesn't have quite the role as Banderas even though Phillips portrays Forman Don Luhco. That's probably because the foreman feels it's his fault his men are trapped so he spends much time in the background trying to figure things out but blocked by his feelings.

The entire cast does an amazing job as they go from looking dirty and grimy to someone who might have been locked in a tomb for years. Just imagining from my theater seat that this was a real story of people who might face 69 days of starvation, or get ill with nothing to offer relief. made an impact on me of how humble the men must have been.

In between the story of the men in the hole is the story outside the home. Mothers, children, fathers, wives, cousins and neighbors are angry and scared the men aren't being rescued quickly. As one day turns into five, and then 10, and then 15 hope begins to fade especially when the engineers tell them they can figure out a way to drill they would not danger the men even more.

One technique after another is tried to open a space to let the men out, nothing works. They drill and drill, break drills, and stop drilling.

Juliette Binoche, stars as Maria Segovia, sister of one of the miners and the most vocal representative of the families. She refuses to take no from the engineers in charge of the mine or the government. Luckily, Chile President Pinera also realizes this could mean his job if he can't help create a miracle. Fortunately for him, Chilean engineer Andre Sougarret (Gabriel Byrne) gets to work on how to figure out a way to rescue the men. He also becomes the liaison between the families who now stay day and night behind the picket fence watching the drilling or the silencing of the drilling and crving their hearts out.

Patricia Reagan does a great



job directing this film with all its complicated elements. Producer Mike Medavoy said, "Patricia was the perfect choice to direct this film. She is one of a few women directors working today and, being from Latin America, she had such a heart for the material. She totally captured the layers of fear, hope, desperation, faith, anger and joy that ebb and flow throughout the film."

The film reveals the never before seen actual events that unfolded above and below ground. I found *The 33* riveting, inspiring and totally agree with what Banderas said about his role.

"The key for me was that the efforts to rescue the miners were successful because of the families pushing the government to do something," he said. "To fully understand this story, you have to see both the down and the up – what happened in the mine and what happened above. When you get the whole picture, it says so much about love and the value of individuals. It's a celebration of life."





to the tune of a 33-3 blowout score. This loss solidified the (2-8) Chargers hold on last place in the division sharing the worst record in the AFC with two others (Cleveland, Tennessee).

Totally embarrassed in their house, fresh off a bye week, the Chargers appeared to be anything but fresh. Kansas City definitely looked and played like the better team.

Dropped passes, missed open receivers, no run game and the lack of ability to stop the run not to mention poor special teams play and additional injuries added to a humbling loss by the Bolts Sunday.

Chargers quarterback Philip Rivers uncharacteristically had no touchdown passes. Rushed and harassed constantly Rivers completed 19-of 30 passes for 178-yards, a dismal 65.7 rating. Chiefs linebacker Justin Houston caught one of Rivers passes and rumbled 17-yards to the end zone for a pick six in the third quarter. In the fourth quarter the Bolts defense allowed two Spencer Ware 3-yard running scores to cap a 21-unanswered Kansas City scoring binge to secure the blowout win, giving up only one Chargers field goal.

- teaspoon maple extract Chopped honey roasted pecans, optional Mini marshmallows, optional

Heat oven to 350 F.

In large bowl using hand mixer or paddle attachment, cream together shortening and brown sugar. Add egg and sweet potato and mix until combined.

In small bowl combine flour, baking soda, salt and pumpkin pie spice. With mixer on low speed, slowly add flour mixture until well mixed. Use a small cookie scoop and drop rounds onto greased baking sheets. Bake 10-12 minutes or until golden brown. Cool completely

before frosting

In separate bowl, beat together butter, powdered sugar and maple extract until frosting is light and fluffy. Frost each cooled cookie with maple butter cream frosting. Sprinkle with pecans and mini marshmallows, if using. Carefully toast marshmallows with a culinary torch, avoiding melting frosting, if desired.





Loaded Mashed **Potato Dinner Rolls** Prep time: 15 minutes Cook time: 25 minutes

- Makes: 24 rolls 1 package Bob Evans **Original Mashed** Potatoes, divided
 - 1 cup Bob Évans Thick Sliced Hardwood Smoked Bacon
 - 2 cups cheddar cheese, shredded 2 green onions, small
 - diced Salt and black pepper,
 - to taste 1 package dinner roll dough (24 rolls)
 - tablespoons butter, unsalted and melted 4

Heat oven to 350 F. To make filling, in mixing bowl combine mashed potatoes, bacon, cheese, onion, salt and pepper. Stir until combined.

Flatten dough into round using palm of hand, spoon 2 tablespoons of filling in middle. Place on baking tray. Brush surface of rolls with melted butter and cut cross pattern with sharp scissor at middle until you can

see filling. Bake rolls until golden brown, about 20-25 minutes. Remove from pan and cool at room temperature for 5 minutes. While cooling, brush tops with melted butter.



Bacon Wrapped White Cheddar Jalapeno Poppers

Prep time: 30 minutes Cook time: 25-35 minutes Makes: 40 poppers

- 2 packages Bob Evans Thick Sliced Bacon, slices cut in half 1 package Bob Evans White
- **Cheddar Mashed Potatoes**
- 1 package garlic herb cheese spread
- 20 jalapeno peppers, halved and seeded with membranes removed
- cup brown sugar teaspoon cayenne pepper,
- ground

Heat oven to 400 F. Bring bacon to room temperature so it is pliable and easy to work with.

In mixing bowl, combine mashed potatoes and garlic herb cheese with rubber spatula. Stir until incorporated. Spread approximately I teaspoon mashed potato mixture in each ialapeno half; level off with butter knife or spatula. Be sure not to heap potato mixture or it will spill out of peppers. Wrap each jala-peno with bacon; use 3 half slices for large jalapenos or 2 halves for smaller sizes. Be sure bacon is wrapped to seal in mashed potato mixture tightly

In small mixing bowl, combine brown sugar and cayenne pepper. Generously sprinkle bacon with brown sugar and pat gently to make it stick to bacon. Line cookie sheet with parchment paper and place wrapped peppers on sheet. Bake until bacon reaches desired crispiness,

about 25-35 minutes. Let peppers cool slightly before serving, about 5 minutes.
