San Diego County makes the nice list

Lots of economic benefits expected this Holiday season

San Diego County appears to have made the "nice list" this holiday season. Barring last-minute misbehavior, the region's economy can expect several significant gifts this December, according to a SANDAG look at projected activity.

SANDAG chief economist Ray Major broke down national and regional statistics to highlight some of the key factors that will impact San Diego County during the holidays. Some interesting projections include:

Holiday spending in San Diego County

- \$5.3 billion — total dollars to be dedicated to retail and food service spending in December

- \$1,600 — average amount each resident will spend on food and retail purchases in December

- \$900 — average amount adults will spend on holiday gifts

- Nearly 20 percent — expected spending increase by residents in December on retail and food services compared to other months of the year

Holiday jobs

- 30,000 — number of seasonal jobs that will be supported by the holiday season in San Diego County
- \$32 million — total salaries to be earned by these seasonal workers during the holidays

Holiday travel

- 91 — percentage of visitors who will come to San Diego County by car in December
- 378,000 — additional cars that will travel to San Diego County in December
- 104 million — total number of additional miles expected to be logged by car visitors while traveling to the region in December (4,200 trips around the world)

ber of additional miles expected to be logged by car visitors while traveling to the region in December (4,200 trips around the world)

Holiday Tourism*

- 1.1 million — number of additional visitors expected in the San Diego region during the month of December

- Get enough sleep. Preferably eight hours.

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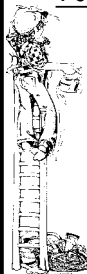

Cinnamaldehyde may support healthy kidney function*



Cinnamaldehyde, the main chemical constituent of Cinnamon and Cassia essential oils, is well known for its warm, spicy aroma. Four free-Range holiday decorations

Today we're not talking about food. Don't worry—as we approach the holidays, there's going to be plenty of food talk. But, there's more to the holidays than food . . . like the decorations! And I don't know about you, but factory-made plastic doesn't really say Christmas to me.

Now, we all have our favorite holiday ornaments and trinkets that we take out every year, but it's also nice to get outside and forage for beautiful (free) stuff to decorate with. This is a great thing to do with kids, by the way! Much nicer to take them outside to scavenge for decorations than to haul them through crazy lineups at those big-box stores for more stuff that's going to eventually end up in a landfill.

If you haven't foraged for holiday decorations before, you're going to love this. No

matter where you live, I'm sure you'll be able to find some great free stuff right outside your front door (or at least not too far away!).

The following are some decorative items you may have right outside your home that won't cost you a penny:

Pine cones. Pine cones look perfectly festive without any adornment at all, though some enjoy dipping them in glitter or spraying them with fake snow. Tie them from the Christmas tree or use as a centerpiece. Use your imagination!

Fresh tree boughs. Take some branches from the cedar, pine, or fir trees growing in your yard. This is the time to bring them inside so they're fresh for Christmas. You can use these for garlands, wreaths, swags . . . whatever you like! Pound the cut ends with a hammer—they'll absorb more water this way. Then, soak them overnight in the tub to

allow them to become as hydrated as possible.

Twigs. Twigs and boughs look beautiful with cut flowers, so look around for a perfect collection of twigs and slender branches. Again, you can keep them au naturel or dip them in glitter.

Bark and moss. Birch bark is gorgeous, and I'm sure you'll find a use for it. If you can find some moss, bring it in and use it to top the soil in your potted plants. This will make them look all dressed up for the holidays.

Look around and see if there are some dried flowers in the yard. If you dried your hydrangeas this fall, now would be the time to take them out and put them on display!

Maybe you're lucky enough to have a holly bush in the garden! Or some bayberry bushes—those will smell wonderful in the house! Search for items that look and smell beautiful and haul them inside. (Caution: Do be careful with bringing berries inside if you have pets—some varieties of berries (including holly) are poisonous to dogs and cats.)

Dust off your large garden urns and start putting some arrangements together! If you have no urns, buckets wrapped in brown paper and tied with twine will do just fine.

Safety tip: No candles in the twigs and bark, okay? If you want to add lights to your fresh greens, use LED—they're not as hot as the older style lights.

The 2014 Globe for All program of taking a play to venues in the community to present professional theatre was very successful. Last year it was *All's Well That Ends Well*. This year the Globe for All program took Shakespeare's *Much Ado About Nothing* to Community centers, Veterans Village, Father Joe's Village, several libraries, Naval Base San Diego, and two prisons, Las Colinas Detention and Reentry Facility (LCDRCF) and Centinela California State Prison.

I attended the Globe visit at Centinela Prison last year and was impressed how quickly the

inmates took to the play, many who had never seen or read anything about Shakespeare. It was hard to decide who had more fun, the actors or the audience.

Two weeks ago I attended the Globe for All Program at San Diego County Las Colinas Detention Facility. Shakespeare's *Much Ado About Nothing* was the play. My first look at the \$268 million prison itself was surprising how modern it looks. With a goal in mind of rehabilitation instead of punishment, architecture firms, KMD and HMC choose a design closer to that of colleges and hospitals that is more open and adaptable. Richard Wener, an environmental psychologist at New York University, was also involved in the new plans.

At 5:30 the Globe cast, staff and creative team members began to set up props for the play. At 7 p.m. nearly 100 female inmates filed in and were seated in a square of four rows surrounding the play area.

Watching their faces as the

actors began to take their places clearly revealed they had no idea what they were in for with this event. The cast included Monique Gaffney (Beatrice, Sexton), Christopher Salazar (Benedick, 1st Watchman), graduate of the Old Globe/University of San Diego Graduate Theatre Program; and recent Old Globe/USD M.F.A. Program graduates Lindsay Brill (Margaret, Verges, Friar Francis), Charlotte Bydwell (Hero), Lowell Byers (Don John, Dogberry, Antonio, Messenger), Tyler Kent (Don Pedro, Conrade), Patrick Zeller (Leonato, Borachio, Balthazar), and Jamal Douglas (Claudio, 2nd Wa.)

The play was directed by renowned Shakespearean Rob Melrose. The creative staff included Robin Sanford Roberts (Scenic Design), Charlotte Devaux (Costume Design), Clinton Davis (Original Music, Music Director), and Diana Moser (Production Stage Manager). Local musicians, Mark Danisovszky and Clinton Davis added an extra element of fun to the show with tunes like the "Keystone Cops."

That's one of the elements that made this production so entertaining for the ladies as the actors would occasionally go over the top in their dialog and add just a shadow of slapstick comedy by falling on the ground, pretending to row away in a boat or swirling their capes. By this time the majority of the ladies were actually understanding the play and continually laughing so hard some had to wipe away tears.

When the play was over the inmates handed in their surveys of the experience and rushed the actors for autographs.

Many of the actors expressed their enjoyment of performing at the facility. Actor Tyler Kent said, "It's an honor to perform the same text they spoke years ago and to create a show that had them laughing and seeming to get the plot of the play."

‘Brooklyn’ touching and one of the best films this year

As the national critics watch more films for voting than they’ve seen all year it’s always interesting to figure out who will vote for what film. Of course it’s always a mix of stories and usually a pleasant, charming, sweet film would have no

chance to occupy one of those on the award’s list.

This is exactly what I was thinking as I started to watch *Brooklyn*. Actress Saoirse Ronan immediately held my attention as the young Irish girl Eilis Lacey. Eilis lives with her mother and older sister Rose (Fiona Glascott). The two girls get along very well.

Rose has a good job as a bookkeeper, but Eilis makes only a small amount and isn’t happy with her job because of the narrow minded and demanding Mrs. Kelly (Jane

Brennan). When Eilis gets a suggestion from Father Flood (Jim Broadbent) about moving to New York City she has to stop and think. After learning he will set up her lodging in a boarding home and a job, Eilis takes a deep breath and agrees.

Sailing across the ocean on the big ship Eilis gets even more excited about what lies ahead even though she already misses her mother and sister. As the ship sails into the harbor in New York a young woman traveling beside her warns her to watch out for men who like the Dodgers.

Finally settled into a nice job at a department store, and having a room at Irish landlady Mrs. Kehoe’s (Julie Walters) boarding home eases some of Eilis’ angst. Getting use to 1950s Brooklyn isn’t easy for this immigrant, especially since her boss hangs over her every movement telling her how to do her job. Only later does Eilis realize Miss Fortini (Jessica Paré) had her success at heart.

It’s not long before Eilis agrees to go with two of her more permissive roommates to a dance. It’s there the young Italian Tony (Emory Cohen), asks her for a dance. This is the beginning of a relationship with both parties thoroughly thrilled. Tony even takes Eilis have for dinner with his family. Tony has a hard time trying

to charm Eilis and make her feel at home as she’s had to practice to learn how to eat pasta. It doesn’t help when his eight-year-old brother announces to her that the Italians hate the Irish.

Just as Tony and Eilis are becoming infatuated with each other, Eilis faces a crisis back home in Ireland. She decides she must go, and Tony talks her into getting married before she leaves. Once back home facing a dramatic situation, Eilis doesn’t break the news that she’s married. This causes a problem when her friend wants to set her up with Irish lad Jim Farrell (Domhnall Gleeson).

Nick Hornby wrote the screenplay adapted from Colm Tóibín’s 2009 novel *Brooklyn*, one of the most acclaimed novels of the last decade. John Crowley had an excellent cast for this film and does an excellent job in directing. To be able to bond, enjoy, sympathize, and worry about a character all the way through a film is rare these days.

“I was interested in capturing this lovely mix of tones: the comic, the romantic and the

tragic” Hornby said. “Mostly I wanted audiences to go through the wringer with Eilis, to come to love her and the people around her and to be affected by her journey.”

Brooklyn is such a film, and watching it was so pleasurable. Ronan nails her sweet and innocent character so well it’s hard to remember the amazing challenges she’s attained in other films such as *Hanna*, *The Lovely Bones*, and *Atone-ment* for which she received a 2008 Oscar nomination for best actress.

Emory Cohen (*The Place Beyond the Pines*, *The Gambler*) is also terrific as Tony in the way he immediately cares for Eilis but can read her needs as if they’ve been together for years. Their chemistry is very natural. Cohen is most assuredly on track for a long acting career.

More than my surprise at loving this film is the reaction of the critics. At this writing *Brooklyn* had a 99% rating on Rotten Tomatoes, and is gaining more and more votes in several categories as critic groups are releasing their nominations.

San Diego Musical Theatre's 'White Christmas'— a must see

The energy and talent of the San Diego Musical Theatre (SDMT) cast on the opening night of Irving Berlin's *White Christmas* could have lit up the Christmas tree at the White House. Written for the big screen in 1954 by Norman Krasna, Norman Panama and Melvin Frank and directed by Michael Curtiz, the sensational song and dance Paramount production has become a staple of the Christmas season.

SDMT's adaptation of this timeless story is exquisitely carried off by the director, actors, producers, musicians and everyone involved. The opening scene is set in the Western front of World War II on Christmas Eve, 1944. General Waverley (Ed Hollingsworth) is a little blue when he thanks his troops for their service as they ready to move on with their lives.

Bob Wallace (David Engel), along with Phil Davis (Jeffrey Scott Parsons), gear up the

holiday spirit with the troops dancing and singing until they need to decide their next steps. Phil already has part of that figured out as he's met two dancers he wants to introduce Bob to; sisters Betty Haynes (Allison Spratt Pearce) and Judy Haynes (Tro Shaw).

While, Phil and Judy develop and instant attraction, David and Betty get off on the wrong foot. Not to worry as the cast is heading off in different directions. David is set to take the company to Florida for a show there. However, the Haynes sisters are already committed to a Christmas show in Vermont. 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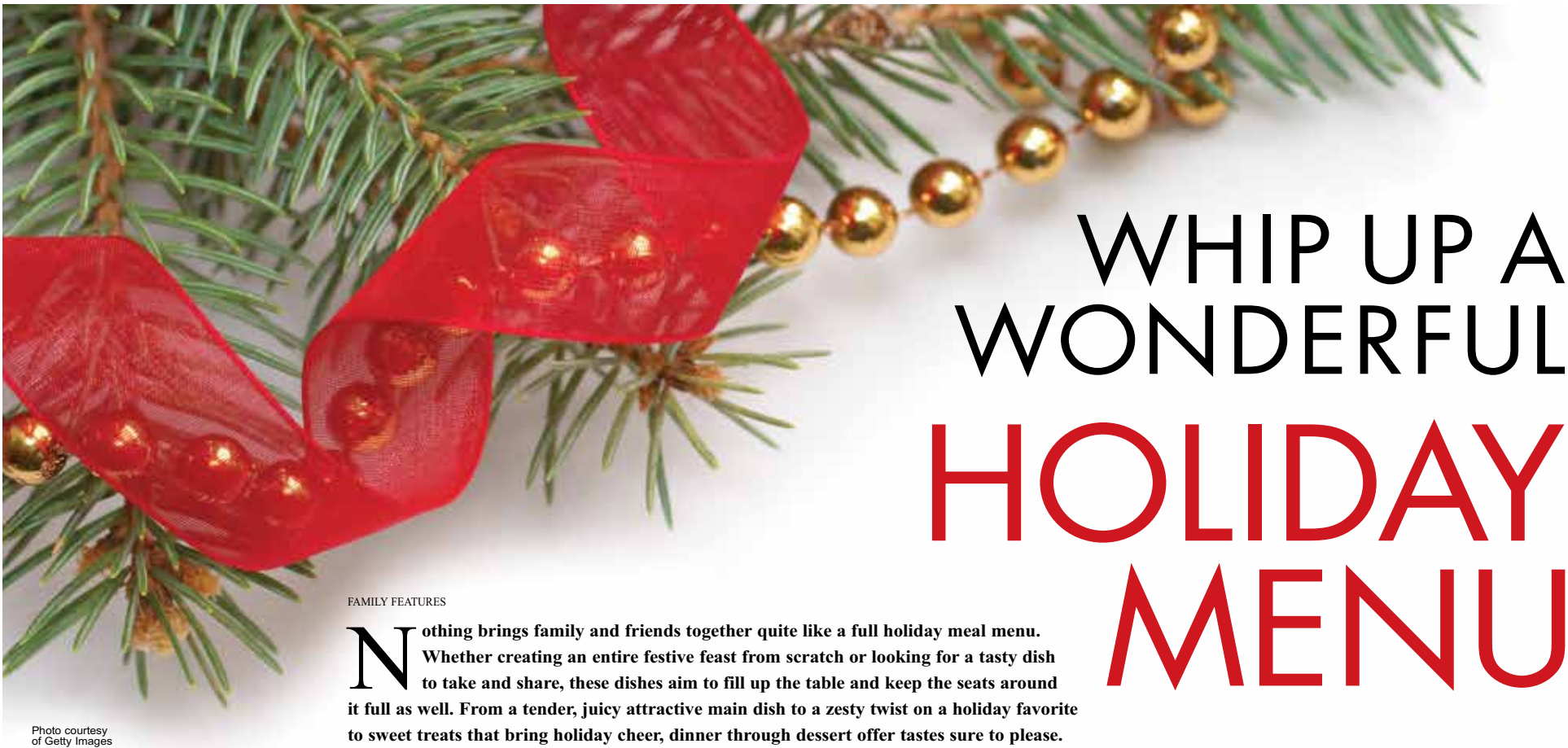

Chargers fans have every reason to feel good this week. At Everbank Field on a warm and humid Jacksonville Sunday afternoon, the (3-8) San Diego Chargers snapped a torrid six-game 56-day losing streak.

"We had some brutal losses. There's no good in a loss in this business," expressed Mike McCoy.

"The whole week of preparation and their great attitude, their belief in what we're doing and to keep on working hard. They haven't blinked. (That was) their attitude on the road trip. They worked hard and kept plugging away. I think the way the players fought. They kept going and made some plays. How special is our quarterback, he's unbelievable," claimed the Chargers Head Coach.

Believe this. Having not scored a touchdown in eight quarters. Philip Rivers threw for 300-yards on 29-of-43 passes, completing four touchdowns. One to Dontrelle Inman and two to Antonio Gates in the second quarter in which the Chargers outscored Jacksonville 21-3. The first Gates touchdown was the 75'th TD pass Rivers has completed to his star tight end. The 76'th soon came after that one on a 12-yard pass from Rivers. Rivers last touchdown was a key fourth quarter score caught by wide receiver Stevie Johnson who caught seven passes in the game. That was impressively believable.

As the Chargers lead diminished to 24-19. With the Bolts facing fourth down and seven at the Jacksonville 38-yard line with nine minutes to play in the game. McCoy gambled

"It was a situation in the game where you got to make that call. We weren't exactly comfortable at that time to kick a field goal. With offensive coordinator) Frank Reich knew ahead of time we were going to do it, he called a good play and Philip made it with his legs," proudly confided McCoy.

Rookie running back Melvin Gordon had a decent game leading all Chargers backs with 60-yards on 14-carries, a 4.29 average.

Chargers defense played well enough to win. Inside linebackers Denzel Perryman led the Bolts with seven tackles. ILB Mantai Te'O also

had a great game culminating with a nice interception that he tipped to himself, a key play in the second quarter. This pick was his second career interception.

On Perryman McCoy said, "There's a number of plays

where you see him run through with the explosiveness and the power he has. He settled down and made a lot of plays the way good football players do. We need more of that."

The Chargers could use more wins as well.

The (9-2) AFC West leading Denver Broncos arrive to San Diego to play the Chargers Sunday fresh off a win at home last Sunday evening against the New England Patriots.
